Re: Approval of Alternative Product Transfer Document Language for Heating Oil

Dear Mr. Morgan,

This letter acknowledges that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed and approved the alternative product transfer document language for heating oil requested by the Petroleum Marketers Association of America.

According to 40 CFR 80.590(a)(7)(vi), for transfers of title or custody of dyed or dyed/marked heating oil, the product transfer document for the heating oil must contain the following statement:

**"Heating Oil: Not for use in highway vehicles or engines or nonroad, locomotive or marine engines."**

As an alternative to the language in 80.590(a)(7)(vi), EPA has approved the following statement to be used on product transfer documents for heating oil:

**"Heating Oil: Not for use in highway, non-road, locomotive or marine engines."**
